Cornell College One Course Summer Institute - <https://www.cornellcollege.edu/one-course-summer-institute/> June 13-29, earn .75 Cornell credits (3 s.h. at a semester school), course choices include theater performance, fiction writing, computer science: virtual reality, applied sport psychology, and DNA/genetics. There is an option to live on-campus or to commute. Students who have completed 10th, 11th or 12th grade may participate.
