**Center Jct.** students will ride John Stender's bus # 9, approximate pick up time 7:00. Drop off time 4:00.

**Onslow** students: West side students will ride Sue Pestka's bus #5, approximate pick up time 7:20 in front of the bank. East side students will ride John Stender's bus #9, approximate pick up time 7:10. Both will drop off at 3:40.

All **Monmouth** students will ride Ron Stender's bus #11, approximate pick up time 7:00. Drop off time 3:54.

*\*Monmouth bus routes will be altered slightly when bridge is completed – approx. 7:09 pick up/3:45 drop.*

**At Wyoming** - All 4th & 5th graders will ride Ron Stender's bus #11. All 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> graders will ride Nancy Collins' bus #2. All preschool, kindergarten and 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will ride Patty Podhaski's bus #12.

After school all OJ students will ride Jim's bus #13 and Lost Nation students will ride Denny Scott's bus #7.

**At OJ** - OJ 6-12 will load on Jim Bicknese's bus #13 for Wyoming.

**At LN** - South side by the Presbyterian Church - All 6-12<sup>th</sup> graders will ride Denny Scott's bus #7. All PS-5 will ride Bruce Petersen's bus #1.

**Please be ready at least 5 minutes early the first few days until schedule is established.** Students need to be ready at your stop when the bus arrives. Buses are NOT required to wait for late students!
