



LNE Communications Community Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements:

Eligible applicants must be enrolled as a graduating high-school student from a recognized Iowa educational facility. Students must reside in a household with a minimum of one service provided by LNE Communications (Internet, Cable Television or Telephone). Applicants must be pursuing advanced education through an accredited community college, trade school, or four year college.

Applicants must complete the standard application form which includes pertinent personal data and attach a copy of their transcript to date. The applicant should also include a brief (500 words maximum) document explaining why they selected their choice of study and how they intend to use their education after graduation. This information should be returned in a sealed envelope to:

Selection:

Application packets must be received in our office or postmarked by **April 10th, 2024**. Applicants will be evaluated and the winners notified in April. Candidates may be contacted via phone and a face-to-face interview may be required to determine the final award winners. Awards will be paid upon proof of registration at an institute of higher education, and will be issued in September to the educational institution.

- Scholarships will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- Recipients agree to allow publication of their image and/or name in marketing material or in company, or regional newspapers.
- Scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender or disability.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Immediate family members of LNE Communications employees or board members are not eligible.
